After a day and night spent loafing about in your shorts and scuba diving on the island, the old girl will then set sail for Cape Town and arrive eight days later, on June 11 - the day before England take on Algeria.

The price, based on two people sharing a cabin, covers accommodation, ship-based activities such as cricket and frog racing, and all food, including some sausage rolls. The price also includes two nights' accommodation when the boat docks in the Mother City, so it acts as a great floating hotel for your convenience.

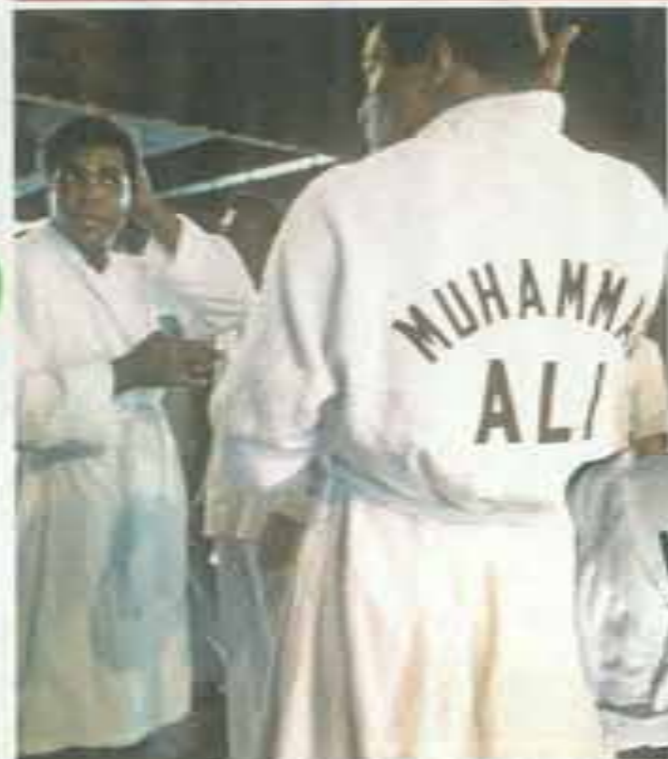

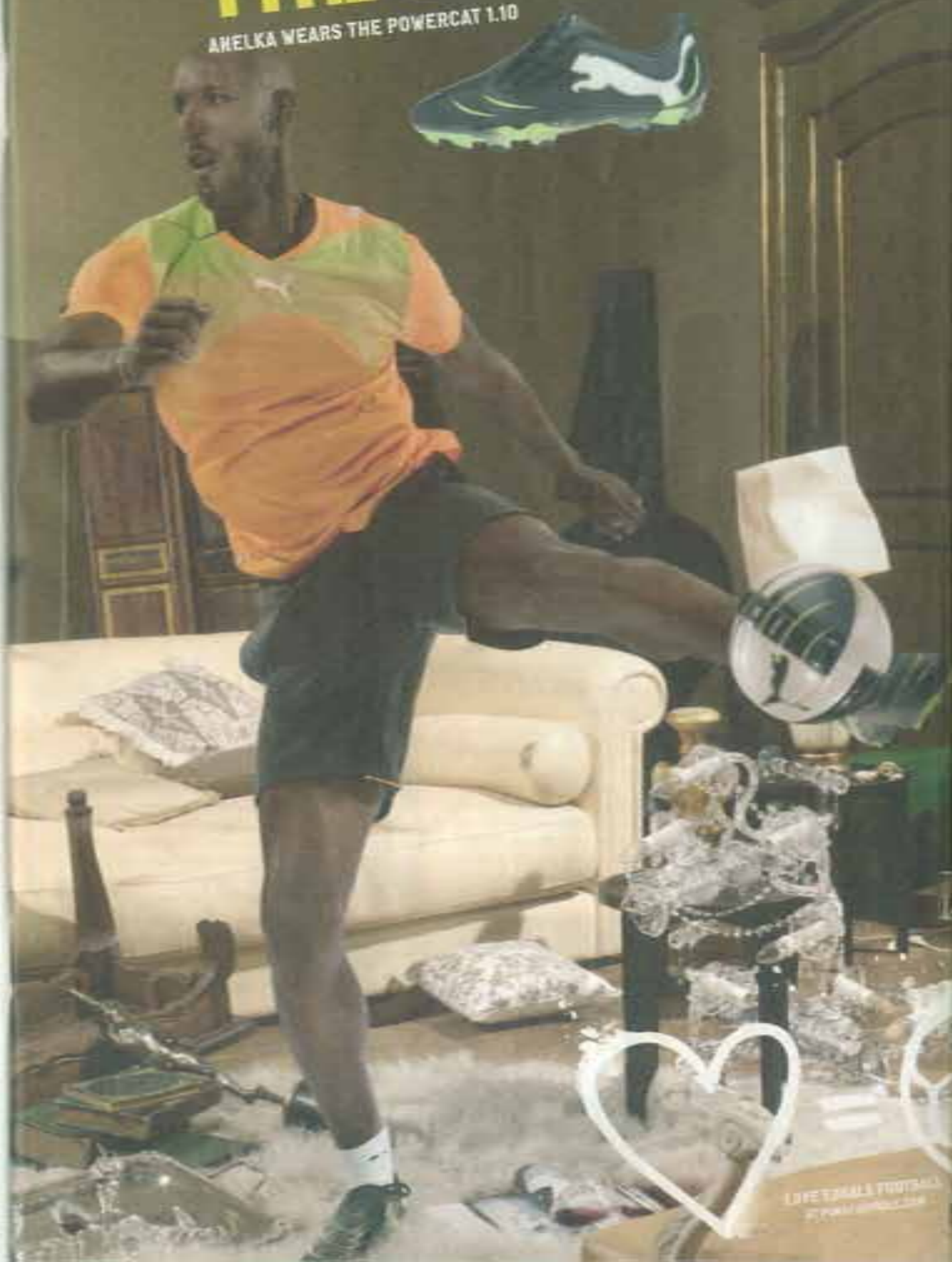

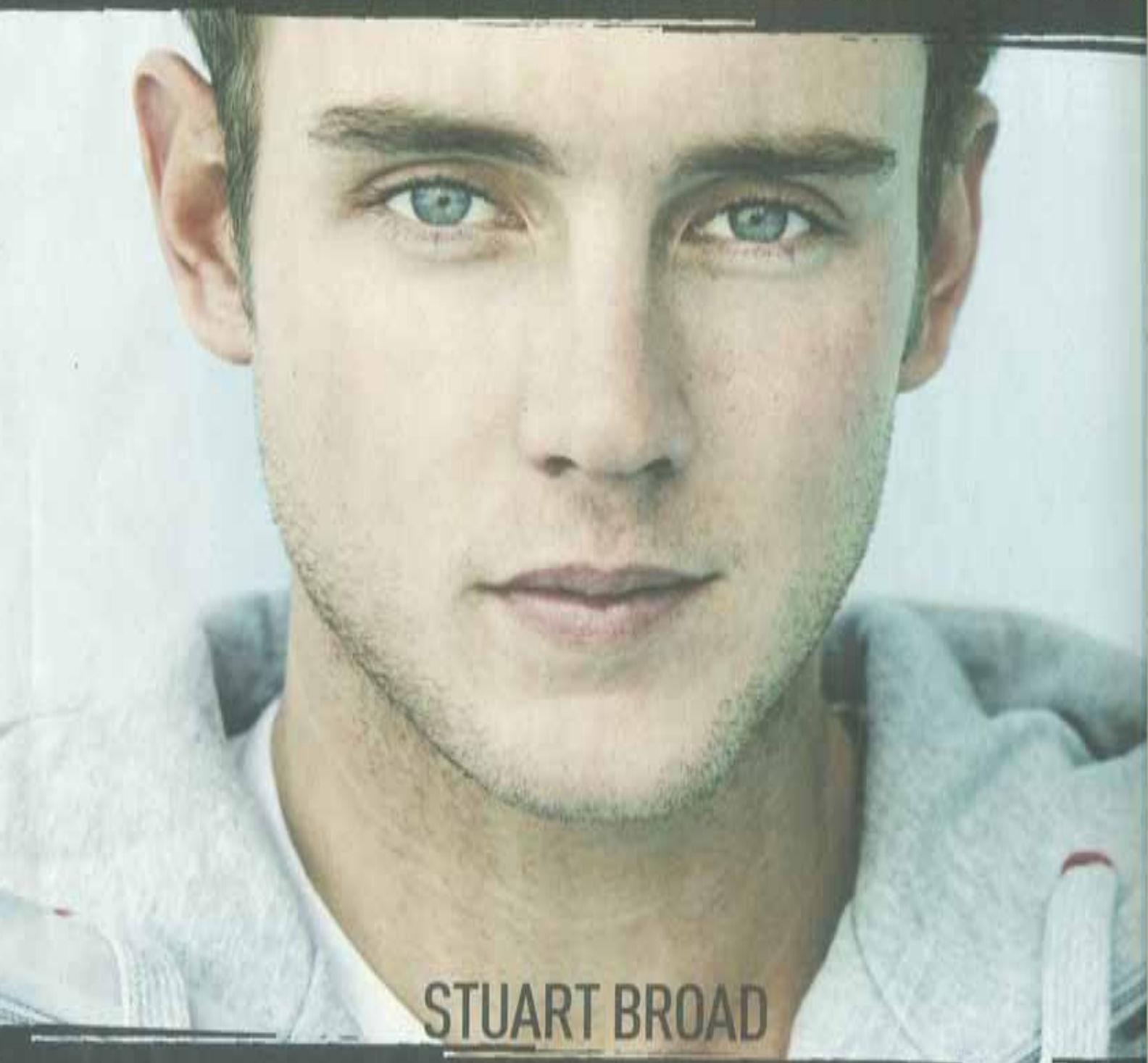
